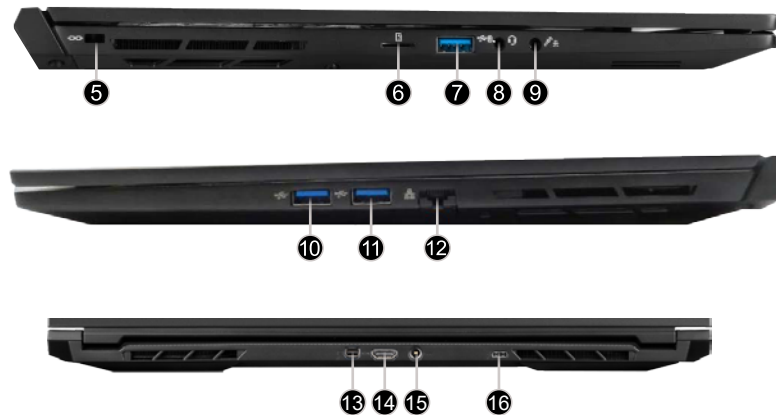

Now you can create a Venom Help Desk account or click the login option in the top menu bar if you already have a Venom Help Desk account.

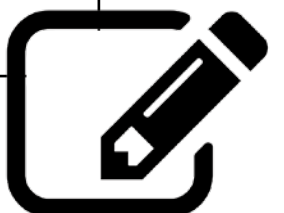
Once logged into your account, register your Venom BlackBook by:

## POST SETUP INFORMATION

### USB RECOVERY DRIVE

**Note: You are not required to use this device upon receipt of your new computer.**

This device is useful in the event you need to restore your Venom software back to factory settings. Please note, operating this device will erase all data on your computer, therefore it is important to back up your data before using this device.

#### How to use:

1. Connect USB Recovery Drive to a USB Port
2. Power on your BlackBook
3. At initial startup, press the 'F2' key two or three times to bring up menu
4. When the menu appears, select Boot Manager & press 'Enter'
5. In Boot Manager, select EFI USB Device (Kingston) & Press 'Enter'
6. Follow the prompts to recover the Operating System

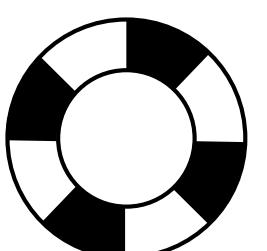

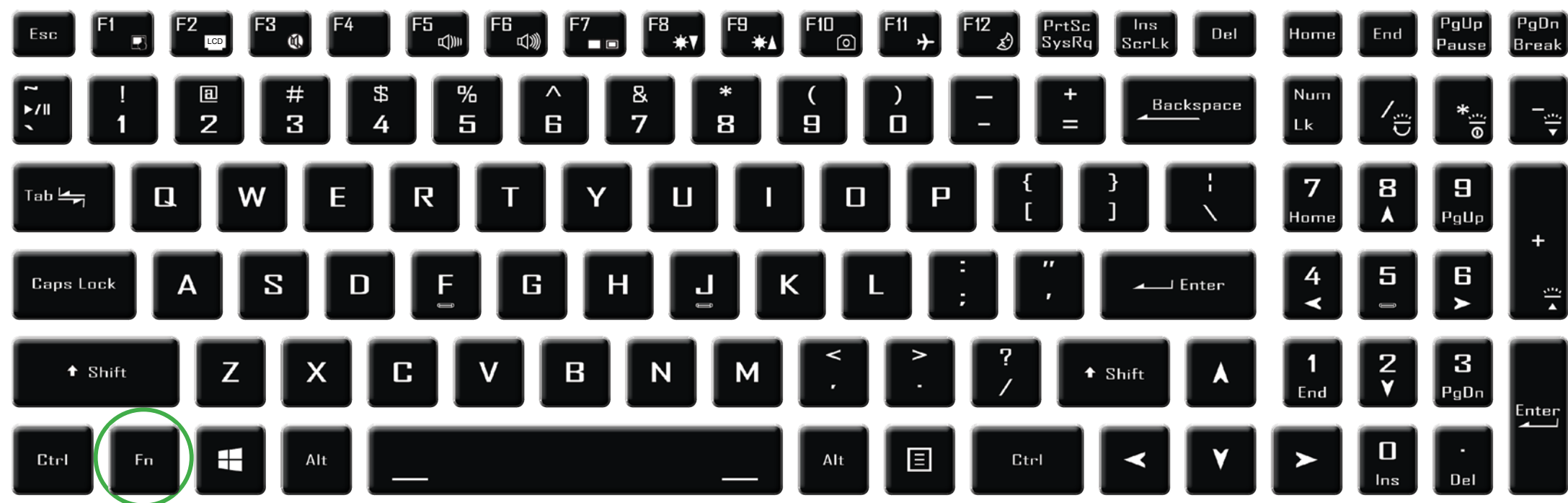

WINDOWS UPDATES

Windows updates are automatic. Your computer may run slower than usual immediately after the initial setup. This is because Windows updates may be running in the background. Your computer may need to restart after these updates.



DO's



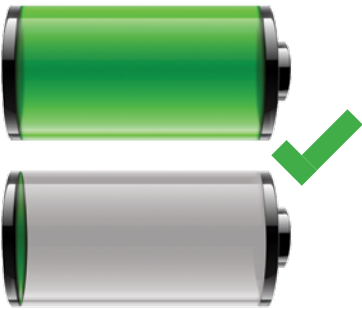
OPEN FROM THE MIDDLE

Opening the lid by holding it from the middle will avoid putting uneven pressure on your computer's hinges.



USE ON FLAT, HARD SURFACE

Always use your Venom on a flat, hard surface. Do not use on carpets, bed spreads, laps, etc.



BATTERY DEEP CYCLING

In order to calibrate and condition a new battery, deep cycling is recommended. Charge the battery up to 100% and then let it discharge down to 2 or 3% capacity. Continue this process for the first 6 cycles to maximise the efficiency of the battery. You may use the computer freely during this process.



SHUT DOWN CORRECTLY

Always shut down your Venom correctly by going to the Windows Start Menu, selecting the power option and then clicking shut down.

DON'T's



DON'T APPLY PRESSURE ON SCREEN

Do not put anything heavy or apply pressure on the screen as this could cause damage.



DON'T SPILL LIQUID

Keep your computer away from liquid at all times.



DON'T KNOCK THE POWER CONNECTOR

Avoid knocking or bumping the connected power adapter as this could cause damage.



DON'T CARRY THE LAPTOP INCORRECTLY

Avoid carrying the laptop from the front whilst open. Always use two hands on either side or put your hand underneath to evenly disperse the weight.
